



STUDENT UNIFORM POLICY

	GIRLS	BOYS	ADDITIONAL
BOTTOM	<p>Khaki/Black colored skirts, flat front pants, shorts or skorts (knee cap or longer) are acceptable. Cargo pants ARE NOT allowed.</p>	<p>Khaki/Black colored flat front pants or shorts (knee cap or longer) are acceptable. Cargo pants ARE NOT allowed.</p>	<p><u>Pants/Skirts/Skorts/Shorts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> May not be baggy or tight fitting such as "skinny pants" or "leggings". May not be rolled at waist. Waist size must be same as student's waist size. Pants, shorts or skirts cannot be made of denim. No "levis," jean or nylon "sweat-pant" material will be allowed. Only the acceptable material and styles for purchase listed in Addendum One. The bottom of the skirt, skorts, and/or shorts must be no higher than 1 inch above the middle of the kneecap when the student is standing. Socks may not be worn over pants. Rubber bands are not allowed on the bottom of pants or ankles. <p><u>T-Shirt:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirts must be long enough to remain tucked in when bending over. Students may wear long sleeve undershirts under polo t-shirt. They can only be white, burgundy or navy blue plain, without ANY logo larger than 2 inches, in accordance with acceptable styles for purchase in Addendum One. The student may choose to button, or not button, the top button of the polo shirt. All other buttons of the polo shirt must be buttoned. Sweaters may not be rolled at the waist. <p><u>Undergarments:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Should not be (visible) through or outside of clothing, tops and bottoms. <p><u>Shoes:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hiking boots and snow boots may be permitted to be worn during bad weather, or as directed for school field trips. <p><u>Personal Appearance:</u></p> <p><u>Jewelry:</u> Boys and girls may wear stud type earrings only, decorations no larger in diameter than a dime, and no dangling or pointed earrings are to be worn - even on free dress days. Only one pair of earrings may be worn, one earring in each earlobe only. Absolutely no gauge style earrings allowed. No extra piercings are allowed. Necklaces may not be visible outside of the clothing.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Acceptable hair accessories (for girls) are listed in Addendum One of this Handbook. Boys may not wear any hair accessories and hair must be kept out of eyes through proper styling. Hair should not be extreme, i.e., no big spikes or hair color that is not natural. No Mohawk style of cut. No shaving the head bald. Hair must be at least ½ inch on the top and ¼ inch on the sides and back. No mustaches or beards. Sideburns may not extend beyond the bottom of the earlobe and may not extend wider than ½
TOP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Navy blue or Burgundy polo style shirts with short or long sleeves listed in acceptable styles of Addendum One (School logo patch affixed on the upper left chest) Navy or Maroon or Burgundy sweater vest or long sleeve sweater, either pull-over or sweat-shirt/cardigan listed in acceptable styles of Addendum One. All tops will carry school logo patch, affixed on the left chest. 		
FOOTWEAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shoes, loafers or sneakers (shoes must be closed toe). Plain, unadorned socks or tights (for girls) must always be worn. 	<p>No sandals, clogs, mules, slippers, flip flops, high heels, platform shoes or shoes with wheels.</p>	
PE UNIFORM	<p>TOP: Plain colored t-shirt, sweatshirt, or pull-over absolutely no logos or writing unless it is a small (smaller than 2") brand label. (I.e. Nike swoosh)</p> <p>BOTTOM: Sweatpants, shorts (Knee-cap rule). No jeans.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> FOOTWEAR: Any athletic type shoes suitable for basketball, tennis, and field sports are allowed. Cleats are not permitted. No inappropriate writing or picture allowed. Students must follow PE uniform policy on free dress days. 		
OUTERWEAR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hats, caps, and other headgear may not be worn in school buildings. No gloves or finger lacing of any sort are allowed. Windbreakers, jean jackets, or ski jackets, may not be worn in the classroom or school buildings. School sweatshirts may be worn or carried, but not tied around the waist.
